AWARDS: One thousand dollars (\$ 1,000.00) is available for cultural grants, to be administered by the institutions in the name of the winner. No recipient will receive more than \$500.00. The committee reserves the right to divide the money as they see fit.

HOW ARE GRANTS AWARDED? Committee selects on the basis of a statement of need written by the applicant, three letters of reference, a chronology of study and a photocopy of the institution brochure.

- iii. A photocopy of the application form and brochure used by the institution to which you have applied or wish to apply.
- iv. A one page handwritten explanation of your educational program and goals with an explanation of your financial need.
